#### ADP

#### KINDERGARTEN SOCCER

One of the main concerns was not having enough staff to oversee the sessions. Bob said there would be 24 sessions each Saturday at approximately 14 locations. Most members were in favor of keeping the status quo or making minimal

changes. A decision has to be made before February which some members thought was not enough time to make a significant change to the K program. Bob will send out the proposal information and David Gould will collect comments/concerns. The committee is asked to send comments/concerns to David.
